

ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN ORDINANCE OF THE
SAN SIMEON ACRES COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
DESIGNATING STOP INTERSECTIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SAN SIMEON ACRES COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT ("District") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. STOP INTERSECTION AUTHORITY. Under the authority of Section 21354 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California and subject to the provisions of Section 21353 of said Code, the District may designate any intersection under its exclusive jurisdiction as a stop intersection and erect stop signs at one or more entrances thereto. Such stop signs shall conform to the specifications set forth in Section 21400 of the Vehicle Code.

SECTION 2. INTERSECTION DEFINED. "Intersection," as used in this ordinance, shall have a meaning ascribed to that term in Division 1 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California.

SECTION 3. SIGN PLACEMENT DUTY. When stop signs are authorized by this ordinance to be erected as permitted under the provisions of the Vehicle Code, it shall become the duty of the District's road manager to place and maintain or cause to be placed and maintained, appropriate stop signs as directed in the said ordinance, conforming to the specifications as set forth in the Vehicle Code for such stop signs.

SECTION 4. STOP INTERSECTIONS. The following shall be designated as stop intersections:

A. Otter Way at Avonne Avenue. The westerly intersection of Otter Way (District Road No. 8359) with Avonne Avenue (District Road No. 8218) is designated a stop intersection and a stop sign shall be erected at or near the entrance thereto.

B. Avonne Avenue at Pico Avenue. The southerly intersection of Avonne Avenue (District Road No. 8218) with Pico Avenue (County

Road No. 8220) is designated a stop intersection, and a stop sign shall be erected at or near the entrance thereto.


SECTION 5. STOP REQUIREMENTS. Pursuant to Sections 21461 and 22450 of the Vehicle Code, the driver of any vehicle approaching a stop sign at the entrance to, or within, an intersection, or railroad grade crossing shall stop at a limit line, if marked, otherwise before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection.

SECTION 6. PENALTY FOR VIOLATION. Pursuant to Section 40000.1 of the Vehicle Code, any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished as provided in Division 18 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance, it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Directors voting for and against the ordinance in the Cambrian, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California.


