WELLHEAD TREATMENT COMPLETION

Good news San Simeon! The Wellhead Treatment Project has been completed and the State Division of Drinking Water has permitted the project. Typically, ground water chlorides start increasing around September or October, which is when we anticipate operating the treatment system. Staff has been working with the treatment system to optimize operations and to maintain the equipment. Engineering has performed a sound test to make sure that treatment process, while in operation, meets County standards, is not audible by nearby residents or create a nuisance noise. We were very pleased with the results. Neither the Mobile Home Park or the closest neighbor and condominiums were bothered by noise whatsoever. The equipment is state of the art technology and causes very little noise. The Zebras and the cattle will not be upset at all.

To cover a majority of the project cost, we received a Grant (free money) from the USDA (United States Department of Agriculture) of \$500,000, and a reimbursement Grant from the State for \$362,431. The costs of construction, equipment and building are anticipated to be \$914,540. We are very pleased with this outcome and we hope you are too. San Simeon users will no longer have to deal with salty coffee, curdling creamer or potential appliance problems as a result of the long term use of hard water. It will be completely up to each user if you want to continue to pay for your personal reverse osmosis units at your homes. Staff feels that it should no longer be needed, but each home owner and hotel will have to make that decision for themselves.

RATE INCREASE

In the last two billing statements, you were prompted of the July billing increase. Per Ordinance 110 passed on November 11, 2011, it is time for a rate increase to be initiated. Per Ordinance 110 the increase is 5% plus CPI (cost price index) which was 0.9%. Effective in the July billing the monthly service fee is \$30.82, water per unit is \$11.01, and sewer per unit is \$8.28 for residents. Please look to the left side of your bill for your new monthly rates. If you would like assistance with deciphering your bill, please call the District Office 805-927-4778.

The rate increases help the District maintain and improve your facilities, qualify for grants and or loans for new equipment such as the Well Head Treatment Project and to be better prepared in case of an emergency. Currently the next project the District is focusing on is the replacement and expansion of the District's water storage reservoir.

We only have a 150,000 gallon reservoir of potable water. Cal Fire requires 400,000 gallons of water to be available in storage to put out a Fire. We also have two fire hydrants with low pressure due to small distribution feed lines. Staff approached Phoenix Engineering a few years ago to provide the District with preliminary design concepts and cost estimates for the reservoir project and preliminary costs are in the millions. With the constant impending salt water intrusion problem, the District focused its efforts on the Wellhead Rehab Project, which was completed in 2012 and the now completed Wellhead Treatment Project. The expansion of the reservoir will be of benefit to the community in the event of a fire, and will replace the existing approximately 50 year old reservoir. Staff of course has started the search for Grants to help the District pay for some of the project cost. Please review current and future Board Packets to keep updated with Staff's progress

on this next project. The District Board and Staff are grateful for the constant support the San Simeon Community has given this team during the progress made these past 11 years. We hope to continue to make improvements within the community so that we continue to be proud of where we live.
