

ORDINANCE NO. 88

AN ORDINANCE OF THE  
SAN SIMEON COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT  
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 67

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SAN SIMEON  
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1: AMENDMENT:** That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 67 is hereby deleted  
in its entirety and replaced and amended to read in its entirety as follows:

**SECTION 2 - PARKING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AND  
TRAILERS:** No recreational vehicle as defined in Health and Safety  
Code Section 18010, semi-trailer as defined in Vehicle Code Section 550,  
trailer as defined in Vehicle Code Section 630, trailer coach as defined in  
Vehicle Code Section 635, or truck tractor as defined in Vehicle Code  
Section 655 shall be parked or left standing between the hours of Midnight  
and 6:00 A.M. upon any street within the San Simeon Community  
Services District ("District") owned or maintained by the District unless  
a permit has first been issued therefor by the Manager of the District or  
an authorized representative of the District.

**SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.** If any subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, or  
phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of  
competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the validity or  
enforcement of the remaining portions of this ordinance, or of any other provisions of other  
ordinances of the District. It is the District's express intent that each remaining portion would  
have been adopted irrespective of the fact that one or more subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences,  
clauses or phrases be declared invalid or unenforceable.

**SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately  
upon its adoption.

**SECTION 4: PUBLICATION.** Within fifteen (15) days of passage, this ordinance shall  
be published one time in a newspaper of general circulation published in the District, if there is  
one, and if not, then this ordinance shall be posted for one week in three (3) public places in the  
District.
