PARKING: RV's

If you have friends or family planning to visit San Simeon with their RV or trailer that will need to be parked on District streets, please remember that you must get a permit from the District Office. SSCSD Ordinance 107 details the RV parking permit requirements. We ask hotels that have patrons with RV's to park on hotel property or obtain a parking permit from the SSCSD if street parking is necessary. RV parking on County easements is strictly prohibited and clearly posted.

The parking permit is to keep tourists from camping on our streets. In the past some took up permanent residence on District streets, leaving behind litter and sewage. Please inform SSCSD Staff whenever you see an RV on District streets without a bright pink parking permit. The permit should always be posted on the driver's side window. We thank you for your assistance in this matter.

SANDBAGS: FILLING & LOADING TIPS

Sand and empty sandbags are available at the District office free of charge. Please feel free to help yourself. Here are some general tips to help prevent injuries when filling and loading sandbags:

- Use gloves to protect hands from chemically-treated sandbags and contaminants in sand and floodwater.
- Avoid touching your eyes and mouth.

- Wear work boots (waterproofed if working in floodwater.)
- Use waterproof gear if working in floodwater or rain.
- Remember, sandbags may be small, but they are heavy. Use care when lifting.
- Do not overfill sandbags fill bag 1/2 to 2/3 full.
- Keep load in front of and close to your body.
- Keep the lift between knee and waist height.
- Do not reach out, bend over, or twist when lifting.
- Lift with your legs, not your back.
- Use a good hand grip when lifting.
