ORDINANCE NO. 51

AN ORDINANCE OF THE SAN SIMEON ACRES COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT PROHIBITING THE STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING OF VEHICLES ON BALBOA AVENUE DURING CERTAIN HOURS, AND REQUIRING PROPER PLACEMENT OF SIGNS OR MARKINGS GIVING ADEQUATE NOTICE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the orderly flow of traffic on Balboa Avenue within the San Simeon Acres Community Services District is being impeded by, and the available parking spaces being utilized by, certain persons who park on said avenue; and

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 provides that the District may from time to time prohibit or restrict the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles upon any public street in the District; and such prohibition or restriction may be effectuated by ordinance of the District specifying the streets and prohibitions or restrictions on standing, stopping or parking thereon, followed by the proper placement of signs or markings giving adequate notice thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on both sides of Balboa Avenue within the District during and between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. be hereby prohibited;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the San Simeon Acres Community Services District as follows:

SECTION I. PROHIBITIONS.

Pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 22507, no operator of any vehicle shall stop, stand or park said vehicle on Balboa Avenue within the San Simeon Acres Community Services District during and between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M.

SECTION II. SIGNING.

Pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 22507, the provisions of Section I herein shall not be effective until signs or markings giving adequate notice of the parking prohibitions or restrictions have been placed within the District as prescribed by law.

SECTION III. PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of an infraction and upon conviction thereof shall be punished as follows:

1. A fine not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the first violation of this Ordinance.
2. A fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for a second violation of this Ordinance within a year.
3. A fine not exceeding Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for each additional violation of this Ordinance within one year.

SECTION IV. ENABLING LAW.

This Ordinance is passed and adopted pursuant to the provisions of an Act of the State of California, known as the Community Services District Law, found in California Government Code, Sections 61000 et seq. and particularly Section 61621.5 thereof.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after passage and within fifteen (15) days thereof shall be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the County of San Luis Obispo, California.


